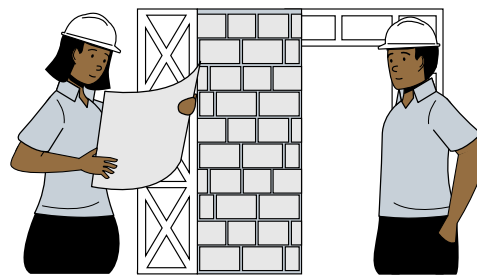


Thank You for Your Submission! What's Next?

Your application for professional registration with ECSA will go through the following steps:

DESKTOP ASSESSMENT

- **Vetting:** Your application is checked for completion and accuracy. During vetting you may be asked to supply further information. Once your application passes the vetting stage, you will be sent an invoice for the balance of the application fee. Once paid, the application proceeds to the EA stage.
- **Experience Appraisal (EA):** Your application is assessed in detail by peer assessors and a moderator if required.



POSSIBLE OUTCOMES OF EA PROCESS:

- **Proceed to the Professional Review (PR):** Competence is indicated from the EA.
- **Proceed to the PR on conditions:** Additional information to be supplied at PR.
- **Abeyance:** If competence is not indicated, your application may be placed in abeyance for 10 months.
- **Refusal**

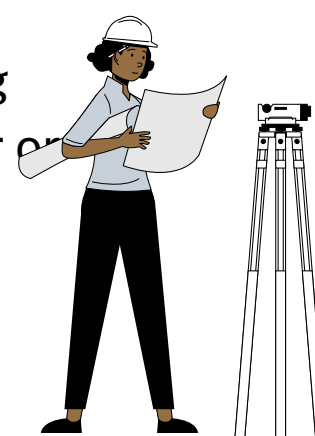
PROFESSIONAL REVIEW

- **Professional Review (PR):** Compulsory interview providing applicant an opportunity to show evidence of meeting all eleven (11) competency outcomes before a panel of peer reviewers.

Format: MS Teams - Video Call

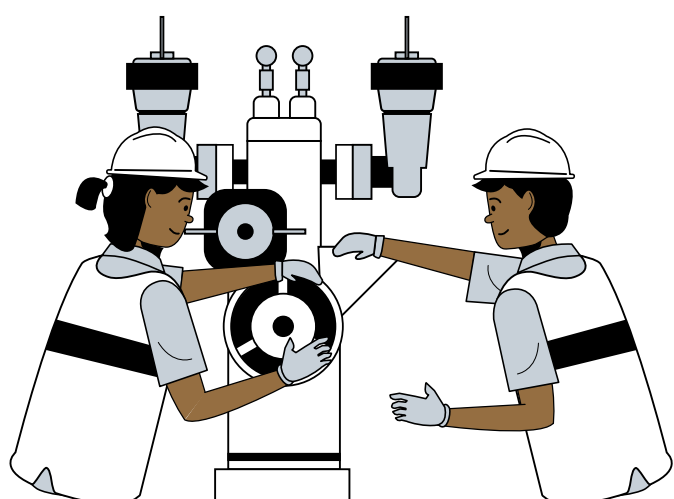
Focus: Present an overview of your training and experience followed by questions to probe competence.

- **Moderation:** Final stage of application process, during which the moderator recommends whether to register or refuse the applicant.



POSSIBLE DECISIONS OF PR MODERATION:

- **Registered:** Upon registration, the registered person receives a PrivySeal digital certificate and becomes subject to ECSA's Code of Conduct, Codes of Practice, and CPD Rules.
- **Refusal:** If refused, the applicant is required to attend an advisory interview for further feedback. An appeal process is also in place if applicable.



TIMELINE:

The processing time from application (if the application is administratively complete) to outcome, is 4-5 months.
